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## **1 INTRODUCTION**

Sree Ayyappa Nursing School under PSN Education & Charitable Trust, offers Diploma Program in General Nursing and Midwifery with approval from Kerala Nurses and Midwifery Council in the year 2025 . The annual intake of students to the GNM course in the school is 40. The school is located at Vadasserikkara in Pathanamthitta district.

## **2 VISION AND MISSION AND PHILOSOPHY**

To Prepare Nurses To Practice Comprehensive Nursing Care In Hospital As Well As In The Community By Means Of A Planned Education Program.

To Provide A Base For Advanced Study And Specialization In Nursing Which Will Assist Nurses In Their Personal And Professional Development So That They Make Their Maximum Contribution To Society As Individuals, Citizens And Nurses.

## **5 ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO GNM COURSE**

1. The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years at the time of application. No relaxation of the minimum age will be allowed.
2. The upper age limit is 35 years. For ANM/ LHV, there is no age bar.
3. Self-attested copy of relevant page of school record namely SSLC/ICSE/CBSE/ certificate showing the date of birth / copy of birth certificate should be produced at the time of admission.
4. Candidates for admission to GNM should have passed 10+2 with English as one subject, must have obtained a minimum of 40 % marks at the qualifying examination and English individually from any recognized board. Science group with Physics, Chemistry, Biology is preferable. In the absence of candidates with science group, candidates with other groups also will be considered. 5% of total marks is relaxed for SC/ST candidates
5. Candidates from State Open School recognized by State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by Central Government are also eligible for admission.
6. Candidates who have passed 10+2 with English having 40% marks in Vocational ANM course from the school recognized by Indian Nursing Council.
7. Registered ANM with pass mark also can apply.
8. Candidates who have passed 10+2 with English having 40% marks in Vocational stream - Health Care Science from a recognized CBSE board/State/Centre are also eligible for application.
9. Students shall be medically fit

## **6 RESERVATION**

- a) For disabled candidates: 5% disability reservation is considered for candidates with a disability of locomotor to the tune of 40% to 50% of the lower extremity. Other eligibility criteria with regard to age and qualification will be the same as prescribed for the GNM Program. Disability certificates should be obtained from the authorized Medical Board of State Government.
- b) 5% is relaxed for SC/ST candidates.

c) Any other quotas as per the state Govt. under the reservation policy.

Note: Reservation shall be applicable within the sanctioned number of seats by INC and KNMC not above it.

## **7 DURATION OF THE COURSE**

The duration of the Diploma Course in General Nursing and Midwifery shall be 3 years. The maximum period allowed to complete GNM course is 6 years

## **8 SYLLABUS**

The syllabus of the course shall be the revised General Nursing Midwifery syllabus 2015 of the Indian Nursing Council.

### **NUMBER OF SEATS**

The total number of seats General Nursing and Midwifery course is **40**.

### **HOW TO APPLY**

The Prospectus and Application Form can be downloaded from the website or can be collected directly from the school office on payment of Rs. 500/- (Five Hundred Only). The payment can be made directly in the office or by DD drawn in favor of – or by UPI. The application fee once paid will not be refunded in any circumstances.

## **10 DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED ALONG WITH THE APPLICATION ARE:**

- a) Scanned image of Passport Size photograph & Name with Signature.
- b) Self attested copies of Mark lists of all parts of Higher Secondary or equivalent Examination and pass certificate in the qualifying examination.
- c) Self-attested copy of the relevant page of S.S.L.C or Equivalent certificate to prove the date of birth.
- d) Equivalency certificate from Higher Secondary Board, Kerala, for candidates who have completed qualifying examination from outside Kerala state.
- e) Caste and income certificate from Village officer/ Tahsildar if the candidate is to be considered under any reservation seat (SC/ST, OBC). There is no need for income certificate for SC/ST candidate

## **11 MODE OF SELECTION /ADMISSION:**

Admission to Diploma in General Nursing and Midwifery will be made on merit as assessed on the basis of the total marks secured by the candidates for the part 3 optional subjects at the plus two examinations /equivalent examination. Science groups with Physics, Chemistry, Biology is preferable. In the absence of candidates with Science group, candidates with other groups also will be considered.

If there is a tie in the total marks in the optional subjects, the candidate with higher marks in English at the +2/equivalent examination will be ranked higher. In case there is still a tie, the candidate with higher total aggregate marks in +2/equivalent examination will be ranked higher. If there is still a tie, the rank will be decided on the basis of date of birth, i.e., the elder person will be ranked higher.

## **12 SELECTION OF THE CANDIDATES**

Candidates will be called for interview and certificate verification by the Selection Committee and select lists will be prepared by the Committee. Candidates should produce original certificates and documents for verification at the time of interview.

**The selection committee will consist of**

- (1) Council Nominee
- (2) A Representative of the Management
- (3) The Principal of the school
- (4) The Vice Principal of the school
- (5) CNO or Nursing superintendent of the Hospital

The select list will be published by the principal, school of nursing on the day of interview

- The selected candidates will be informed about the date and time of admission through the website.
- The students shall pay all fees of the 1<sup>ST</sup> year of the course at the time of admission which will not be refunded at any circumstances.

Mess fee, hostel fee, uniform, medical checkup and text book expenses will be added as extra fee. These fee may vary each year according to the discretion of the management.

If any candidate discontinues the course, after closure of admissions and if such seat cannot be filled up the candidate has to pay liquidated damages equivalent to the tuition fee for the remaining period of the course. The Collection of liquidated damages shall be as per the final decision of the Court of Law.

If any student leave/ discontinue the course after commencement of classes but before closure of admission, the fee paid (after deducting administrative charges) will be paid provided the institution could fill up the vacancy.

In case of discontinuation of course the TC and certificates shall be released on getting bond executed by the student with one of his /her parents undertaking that they shall obey the orders that may be passed by the Court of Law.

#### **14 SPECIAL INSTRUCTION**

(i) **Ragging:** Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in school. School is committed to abolish ragging in the campus. Hence any student who indulges in any form of ragging will be subjected to penal action as per provisions of law. Also the student will be expelled from the institution as detailed in the law concerned and as per Honorable Supreme Court of India directions in this regarding

(ii) **Use of Mobile Phone:** Use of Mobile Phone by students are not allowed during the academic hours. Any violation of this prohibition will lead to stringent disciplinary action by the school authorities.

(iii) Any other items not specifically covered in this prospectus will be decided by the Controller of admission.
